This conference is aimed at the entire disability sector and its theme is very much centred on independence and challenges encountered by people with disabilities, Duration of the conference is two days.

The speakers/presenters are the foremost experts in the disability sector in the world and come from the USA, Belgium and Ireland.

Two of the presenters are themselves wheelchair users. All speakers have committed to, where possible and practical, giving private consultations to as many people as possible throughout the conference.
